UPGRADE OF ELECTRICAL BULK SUPPLY NETWORK – LOUISVALE RD

Bids are hereby invited for the supply and installation of electrical connections in Rosedale, Upington. This tender comprises inter alia the following Works:

Underground 11 kV cable feeders, extension of existing 11 kV circuit breaker panels with an identical 11 kV circuit breakers in AS 11: Brug Street and ES 1 and ES 2: Louisvale Road, bridge/ river crossings with appropriate galvanised steel pipe cable ducting, ducting support structures and an overhead power line with wooden support structures.

Tender documents and specifications are available from BVi Consulting Engineers, 55 Bult Street, P.O. Box 1155, Upington, at an amount of R400,00 in cash or electronic transfer per document, payable to BVi Consulting Engineers. This amount is non-refundable.

Sealed tenders marked, "**CONTRACT TN069 / 2018 (33524): UPGRADE OF ELECTRICAL BULK SUPPLY- LOUISVALE RD, UPINGTON**" must reach the Municipal Manager or be placed in the tender box before or on **Friday 02 November 2018 at 14:00** and will be opened directly thereafter in the Councillors Caucus Room at the Municipal Offices.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at **10:00** promptly on **Friday 19 October 2018** at the offices of BVi Consulting Engineers. The doors will be locked at **10:00** promptly after which no further Tenderers will be allowed. The Certificate that the Tenderer has visited the site will at the same time be signed by the Engineer. For further information, contact the Consulting Engineers, at telephone number (054) 337 6600.

Only representatives of the tenderer will be allowed in the tender meeting who is:

- a) In full time/ part-time employment of the bidder.
- b) Has the adequate experience to comprehend the scope of works.

The following conditions will apply including the Conditions of Tender or Tender Procedures contained in the Tender document:

1. Prices must be valid for ninety (90) days from tender closing date.
2. Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
3. A firm delivery period must be indicated.
4. The tender document must be completed in black Ink by means of a ball point pen. Pencil entries will render the tender offer non-complaint. Computerized/ typed tenders will be disqualified.
5. The Tender document must be completed on the original tender document. Copies of the tender document or parts thereof will render the document non responsive.
6. Bidders are required to provide a realistic construction period, taking into account long leading items.
7. Penalties will be applied for late completion of the Works according to the formula stated in the contract data.
8. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy. The following forms, MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 8 and MBD 9 must be completed and submitted with the bid. Clause 2.1 for functionality will also form part of the tender evaluation.
9. Bids that are late or non-compliant will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
10. A minimum CIDB grading of or 6EP is required for this tender.
11. No B-BBEE points would be allocated if an original / original certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate is not attached to the bid document. An originally certified Sworn Affidavit may be submitted as an alternative. No points will be allocated if a copy of a certified
12. Letter from SARS including PIN to validate TAX clearance and VAT registration should be submitted with the tender offer, the Dawid Kruiper Municipality will confirm the TAX Compliance after tenders are submitted.
13. A valid CSD registration certificate is compulsory and should be included in the bid offer.
14. Proof of registration (Letter/ Registration Certificate) at the Electrical Bargaining Council of South Africa must be included in the Tender Submission.
15. The following compulsory documents must be included in the tender submission:
 - 15.1 Letter from Department of Labour for Registration as an Electrical Contractor in terms of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Electrical Installation Regulations, Regulation No. 5.
 - 15.2 Original certified copy of the intended Electrician's Wiremen's licence.
 - 15.3 Accredited authorization to construct or work with Medium Voltage networks.
 - 15.4 Valid registration of a Construction Health and Safety officer with the SACPCMP.
16. The following bidders are eligible to submit tender offers for evaluation according to the Preferential Procurement Pre-Qualification requirements:
 - 16.1 Minimum Level 2 BBBEE contributor.
17. For Joint Ventures, a signed Joint Venture agreement must be submitted with the tender submission. Additional Joint Venture documents must be submitted as per Tender data F2.1.
