ELECTRIFICATION OF HOUSES IN DAKOTA ROAD, UPINGTON

Bids are hereby invited for the supply and installation of electrical connections in Dakota Road in Upington. This tender comprises inter alia of the following works:

Underground 11kV cable feeder, miniature substation(s), underground low voltage cable reticulation with underground cable service connections and consumer installations.

Tender documents and specifications are available from WorleyParsons RSA (Pty) Ltd, 2 Steenbok Avenue, Private Bag X5879, PostNet Suite 222, Upington, at an amount of R400.00 in cash or electronic transfer per document, payable to WorleyParsons. This amount is non-refundable. EFT's will be accepted up to 10h00 on 11 January 2017 after which cash payments will be accepted up to 10h45.

Sealed tenders marked, "CONTRACT TN023/2016: ELECTRIFICATION OF HOUSES IN DAKOTA ROAD, UPINGTON" must be placed in the tender box before or on Friday 20 January 2017 at 14h00 and will be opened directly thereafter in the Councilors Caucus Room at the Municipal Offices.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at 10h00 promptly on Wednesday, 11 January 2017 at the offices of WorleyParsons. The doors will be locked at 10h00 promptly after which no further Tenderers will be allowed. The Certificate that the Tenderer has visited the site will at the same time be signed by the Engineer. For further information, contact the Consulting Engineers, at telephone number (054) 332 4943.

Only representatives of the tenderer will be allowed in the tender meeting who is:

- a) In full time/part time employment of the bidder
- b) Has the adequate experience to comprehend the scope of works

The following conditions will apply:

1. Prices must be valid for ninety (90) days from tender closing date.
2. Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
3. A firm delivery period must be indicated.
4. The mandatory completion date is 30 June 2017.
5. Penalties will be applied for late completion of the Works. Fines are R200.00/calendar day.
6. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy. The following forms, MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 8 and MBD 9 must be completed and submitted with the bid.
7. Bids that are late or incomplete will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or e-mail will also not be considered.
8. CIDB Grading of EP-6 is required for this Tender.
9. Bidders must be registered at National Treasury's Central Suppliers Data Base (CSD).
10. An original tender tax clearance certificate issued by SARS must accompany all bids as issued on/or before 17 April 2016, and/or the new tax clearance certificate issued as from 18 April 2016, and/or the document issued by SARS indicating the tax clearance PIN. If none of the abovementioned documents are submitted, the bids will not be considered. Please note that it is the responsibility of the supplier to ensure that all tax related matters are in order each day.
11. No B-BBEE points would be allocated if a certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate or a sworn affidavit thereof is not attached to the bid document.
